Rapid expansion in the early 1980s and 90s led Almabani to initiate and execute some work in the reconstruction of Lebanon. The first is the delineation of the borders between the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, the Republic of Yemen and the Sultanate of Oman. The second one consisted in the construction of a complete military city for Dir'Al Jazira forces in the north of Saudi Arabia.

The company has positioned itself well over the years to participate in the execution of many of the prestigious landmark projects in Saudi Arabia. It is currently active in 12 major airport projects in the Kingdom. It has also earned the highest classification in all civil and electrical works, and has built up in-house capabilities to develop, design and value-engineer solutions to cater to our clients' various needs.

Almabani has proudly executed projects ranging from complex infrastructures to heavy civil engineering structures. Now expanding into new markets, the company has been

building its expertise to serve a growing demand for high-quality construction throughout the Middle East and beyond.

Capitalized at 100 million Saudi Riyals (\$26.7 million), a work force of 14,000 professionals of all categories, and with an excellent physical coverage throughout Saudi Arabia, Almabani is well-positioned to continue making significant contributions in the development of the region.

The company is currently engaged in highly-competitive turnkey projects worth billions of dollars. Thanks to its broad, highly-diversified experience, and dedicated team of talented professionals, the company has contributed to the development of the kingdom's major airports and road networks. As a member of the BACS Consortium, which includes Bechtel, Consolidated Contractors Company and Siemens, Almabani is participating in the construction and execution of the Riyadh Metro Lines 1 and 2 Contract, worth \$10 billion.
